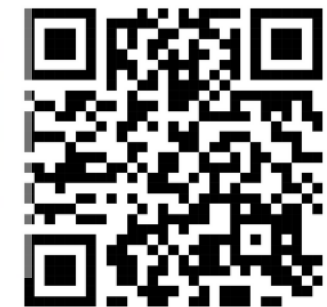

WORK PACKAGE N°2 VALUE ANALYSIS

Work Package 2 aims to define the core and common values, to expand knowledge about values and to learn how values relate to challenging and significant research problems in partner countries. To achieve its goal two surveys has been conducted in partner countries.

The surveys provided insight to our respondents in recognition of the need to better understand how values relate to challenging and significant research problems in society.



VALUE ANALYSIS REPORT

The report delves into attitudes, values, and experiences in partner countries, shedding light on European values, discrimination, climate change awareness, cultural perspectives, and social justice.

In Austria, age-related differences in values emerged, while participants shared agreement on EU values.

Cyprus demonstrated shared perceptions of equality, justice, and sustainability, along with reported discrimination experiences.

Italy revealed consensus on values like environmental sustainability and respect, with migrants highlighting experiences of discrimination.

Latvia placed value on personal freedom, environmental stewardship, and culture, with minimal reported discrimination.

Spain showcased variations in values based on age and education, alongside discrimination experiences reported.

Turkey displayed variations in values based on age, with concerns about climate change and discrimination experiences, underscoring the importance of social justice and equality.

Through this comprehensive analysis, the report provides valuable insights into the diverse landscape of attitudes and values across partner countries.

The next step is to develop and implement a Values Education Program (VEP) that allows participants to reassess their values, promote dialogue, and deepen their understanding of societal values.
